Man loses life after falling into auger.

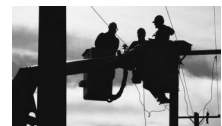


July 31—Tulsa, OK

OSHA CITATIONS

REGION 2

JUNE 09

Albany, NY—Morgan Linen facing proposed fines of [\\$47,600](#) for a variety of violations including fall protection, BBP, respiratory protection.

Metro North Commuter Railroad serving NY, NJ & Conn. is responsible to pay [back wages and \\$300,000](#) punitive damages to 4 employees that filed whistleblower complaints.

JULY 09

Syracuse, NY—Crucible Specialty Metals faces proposed penalty of [\\$249,200](#) following crushing death of employee.

REGION 5

JUNE 2009

Whitehall, WI—Milk Specialties, Co. facing [over \\$1.1 million](#) in possible fines based primarily on CSE and LOTO violations.

JULY 2009

Madison, Wis—Trenching violations lead to a proposed [\\$75,000](#) in fines for MasTec.

Chicago, IL—3 willful and several serious violations led to proposed fines of [\\$314,000](#) for Dana Container.

AUG 2009

Bloomer, Wis—A-1 Excavating, Inc., who is currently contesting \$693,000 in fines, now faces an additional [\\$98,000](#) following April fatality.

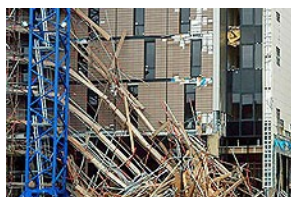
